

RESOURCE DEPARTMENT

Classes at all grade levels receive support in both English and French. Our resource teachers provide help by:

- working with students in small groups or one-on-one, to further understand and reinforce concepts learned in class
- sessions are tailored to meet the specific needs of the group (or student) based on discussions with the classroom teacher
- co-teaching or team-teaching with classroom teachers to help meet the needs of diverse learners
- supporting special education technicians in creating groups to help build skills and strategies within students, such as school readiness skills (BLOOM), social emotional skills, etc.

Learning is facilitated with the use of:

- reading and math programs
- manipulatives
- technology
- educational games

Our resource department is in constant communication with our school board's student services professionals.

WHAT IS BLOOM?

BLOOM is our school readiness program designed for our younger students to help build skills such as following routines, turn taking, play skills and work skills.

K4 AND K5 READINESS

Bilingual Kindergarten is all about learning through play while developing listening, speaking, pre-reading and pre-writing skills in BOTH English and French! Students learn vocabulary words through singing, play and games. They develop vocabulary and understanding through positive reinforcement, encouragement and praise. Students also learn their letters and letter sounds, numbers and pre-math skills and so much more!

Our **K4 program** focuses on school readiness skills so students can build their repertoire of strategies to be lifelong learners!

FOCUS ON S.E.L.

Springdale has a holistic approach to education. Our Social Emotional Learning Committee supports schoolwide and classroom initiatives such as our 60-second resets, kindness shout-outs, morning meetings, to equip students with the academic, social and life skill required in daily life.



EXTRA-CURRICULARS

Springdale has a variety of extra-curriculars that are both academic and interest based. This gives all our students the opportunity to express themselves outside the classroom setting. Here are some of the extra-curriculars offered:

SEED AND LUNCH PROGRAM

Lunch Program Services:

Daily fees for supervision are approx. 2-3\$ per day. Students are supervised in class and outside by a lunch monitor.

SEED Program Services:

- Morning hours 7:00-9:00 am
- After school hours 3:40-6:00 pm
- Approx. \$9.50 /day for students registered at least 3 days a week. Fees are subject to increase each year according to MEES.
- Lunch fees are \$2.63/day
- PED day services and activities are available
- Extended day activities work on both academic and social/emotional skills

WHY SPRINGDALE?

Our Program:

Springdale has a bilingual program where students spend 50% of their academic time in French and 50% in English. In addition students have Physical Education 2-3 times per week as well as Music 2-3 times per week.

- **Phys. Ed.** focuses equally on athletic ability and sportsmanship. Notions of kindness, respect, helpfulness and leadership are developed through physical movement and sports.
- **Music** allows students to discover their artistic creativity through movement and songs, learning to play guitar and ukulele, percussion ensembles, concerts and so much more!
